## 1. Safety Precautions

- Always lift with care; use two or more people if needed.
- Wear gloves to prevent fingerprints and ensure a secure grip.
- Ensure the unpacking area is stable and free from clutter.
- Use appropriate tools: hammer, pry bar, and pliers.

- Metal Statue (Bronze)  
(Solid One-Piece)
- Packed in a sealed wooden box
- Protected internally with  
high-density armor foam/inserts

## 3. Tools You'll Need

- Safety gloves
- Hammer
- Pry bar or crowbar
- Pliers
- Clean, soft cloth
- Optional: Anti-slip pads or felt base



# 4. Unpacking Instructions



## PACKAGE PLACEMENT

Place The Box On A Flat, Sturdy Surface, Preferably Close To The Final Location.



## SAFETY

Put On Gloves For Safe Handling.



## UNPACKING

Using A Hammer And Pry Bar, Carefully Remove Nails Or Staples Securing The Top Panel.



Remove the top and side panels gently to expose the internal armor.



Carefully lift the statue straight up from the foam protection.



Inspect for any transport damage—do not install if damaged.

- Wipe the statue with a clean cloth to remove any dust or packaging residue.



## 5. Weight-Specific Handling Guide

STATUE SIZE	WEIGHT	RECOMMENDED HANDLING METHOD
12"–30"	15LBS–100LBS	Two-person lift / Hand truck
36"–42"	60LBS–160LBS	Hydraulic lift / Pallet jack
60"–80"	150LBS–750LBS	Fork lift with padded forks

- Base sizes vary in height and width, thus affecting the overall sizes. Due to the nature of bronze casting, all dimensions and weights are approximations.

## 6. Installation Guidelines



### Indoor Placement

- All our statues come with a flat base.
- Choose a flat, dry, and stable surface like a floor, altar, or shelf.
- Optionally, add felt or anti-slip pads under the base for surface protection.



### Outdoor Placement

- Although inherently durable, bronze statues are vulnerable to environmental factors such as moisture, air pollution, and temperature fluctuations. These elements can cause discoloration and corrosion, often resulting in the formation of a patina.
- Recommended placement: Stone or concrete base (avoid direct soil or grass). Open-air gardens, terraces, balconies, or temple courtyards.
- Ensure the surface is Level and sturdy.
- Free from standing water or loose gravel.

## 7. Post-Installation Care :

### □ CLEANING:

Regularly clean the statue with a soft cloth and mild soapy water (avoid harsh chemicals) to remove dust and debris.

### □ WAXING:

Apply a protective wax to preserve the patina and protect the bronze from environmental factors.



Ensure statue is level and secure.



Clean with damp cloth (no chemicals).



Applying a thin coat of wax can help protect the patina and maintain its shine.



## 5. Weight-Specific Handling Guide

STATUE SIZE	WEIGHT	RECOMMENDED HANDLING METHOD
12"–42"	8LBS–150LBS	2 OR 3 person lift / Hand truck
60"–80"	60LBS–350LBS	Fork lift with padded forks

- Base sizes vary in height and width, thus affecting the overall sizes. Due to the nature of fiber casting, all dimensions and weights are approximations.

# 6. Installation Guidelines



## Indoor Placement

- ❑ All our statues come with a flat base.
- ❑ Choose a flat, dry, and stable surface like a floor, altar, or shelf
- ❑ Optionally, add felt or anti-slip pads under the base for surface protection.



## Outdoor Placement

- ❑ Fiberglass statues are sensitive to environmental factors. Prolonged UV exposure causes resin breakdown and color fading. Moisture can compromise structural integrity, while temperature fluctuations may lead to cracking or delamination. Chemical exposure, including salts and acids, accelerates surface degradation and discoloration.
- ❑ Recommended placement: Stone or concrete base (avoid direct soil or grass) Open-air gardens, terraces, balconies, or temple courtyards
- ❑ Ensure the surface is Level and sturdy
- ❑ Free from standing water or loose gravel

# 7. Post-Installation Care :

### ❑ REGULAR CLEANING:

Clean the statue regularly with a soft cloth or sponge and a mild soap solution. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive materials that can damage the surface.

### ❑ WEATHER PROTECTION:

For outdoor statues, consider applying a protective coating such as specialized sealants that can help shield sculpture from environmental factors.



Ensure statue is level and secure.



Clean with damp cloth (no chemicals).



Applying specialized sealants can help protect statue from environmental factors

- Marble & Sand Stone Statue
- Indoor/Outdoor
- All Weather Use



## 1. Safety Precautions

- Always lift with care; use two people if needed.
- Wear gloves to prevent fingerprints and ensure a secure grip.
- Avoid tilting, dropping and dragging; marble is fragile and can chip easily.
- Ensure the unpacking area is stable and free from clutter.
- Use appropriate tools: hammer, pry bar, and pliers.

## 2. Package Contents

- Marble or Sand Stone Statue (Solid One-Piece)
- Packed in a sealed wooden box
- Protected internally with high-density armor foam/inserts

## 3. Tools You'll Need

- Safety gloves
- Hammer
- Pry bar or crowbar
- Pliers
- Clean, soft cloth
- Optional: Anti-slip pads or felt base

STATUE SIZE	WEIGHT	RECOMMENDED METHOD
12"–18"	33LBS–99LBS	Two-person lift / Hand truck
22"–24"	110LBS–165LBS	Hydraulic lift / Pallet jack
30"–80"	154LBS–1433LBS	Forklift with padded forks

- Base sizes vary in height and width, thus affecting the overall sizes. Due to the inherent characteristics of natural marble and manual craftsmanship, all dimensions and weights are approximate.

## 6. Installation Guidelines



### Indoor Placement

- All our statues come with a flat base.
- Choose a flat, dry, and stable surface like a floor, altar, or shelf
- Optionally, add felt or anti-slip pads under the base for surface protection.



### Outdoor Placement

- This statue is suitable for any outdoor environment, including rain, heat, and cold however may need some additional care.
- Recommended placement: Stone, concrete, or tile base (avoid direct soil or grass) Open-air gardens, terraces, balconies, or temple courtyards
- No shelter is required, but ensure the surface is: Level and sturdy
- Free from standing water or loose gravel

## 7. Post-Installation Check

- Clean gently with a dry or damp soft cloth.
- Do not use acidic or abrasive cleaners plain water is sufficient.
- **For outdoor use:**
  - Marble is naturally weather-resistant however stone sealant may be required for sandstone.
  - Inspect annually for algae, dust, or bird droppings
  - Avoid applying pressure or dragging the statue during relocation



Ensure statue is level and secure.



Clean with damp cloth (no chemicals).



For outdoor statues, apply stone sealant annually.
